- **FY22** 
  - ► Annual Appropriations: \$5,653,411
  - ► BIL: \$6,148,731
  - ► Total: \$11,802,142
- FY23
  - ► Annual Appropriations: \$5,769,226
  - ► BIL: \$6,453,376
  - ► Total: \$12,222,602

#### FY23 Moving Forward

- Still a focus on disadvantaged and new communities who have not benefited from Brownfields funding yet
- Probably won't bring State and Tribal assessment grants back as an option (may potentially bring back in years 4 or 5 of BIL)
- Likely going back to alternating between RLF and Multipurpose grant competitions starting with Multipurpose in the FY24 competition
- We're hopefully past the challenges we faced last year in awarding the FY22 grants (including start dates beginning on July 1 and clarifying pre-award costs)
  - ▶ R4 has created new "cheat sheets" that will be provided to new grantees
- Grants with cleanup activities will have a new budget line item for construction costs

#### Targeted Brownfields Assessments (TBAs)

- ► The TBA program provides environmental assessment services at eligible Brownfields sites on behalf of eligible entities
  - Phase I and Phase II ESAs, as well as developing cleanup options with cost estimates
  - Services are conducted by an EPA contractor with EPA funding at no cost to the applicant
  - ► TBA applications are available on the our website and accepted anytime throughout the year
- ► TBA applicant and the site to be assessed must meet certain eligibility criteria
  - For example, sites where the TBA applicant is potentially liable for contamination or petroleum sites where there is a viable responsible party are not eligible for TBA assistance
- Region 4 looks to support TBA projects where there is a need for EPA assistance and with the potential to provide benefits to the community
  - Projects in small communities and/or underserved communities, projects that promote environmental justice, and projects where site reuse or redevelopment plans provide community benefits

### IG/OGD Investigation

- ► 17 Region 4 grantees were involved in the IG/OGD investigations due to potential procurement issues
- ► Please make sure your communities aren't borrowing RFPs/language from consultants or other communities
  - ► HQ creating some guidance documents (separate from MARC FAQs)
  - We're in the process of drafting a contracting fact sheet that will go out to grantees with the award information
  - We're also working with our TAB provider to have RFP examples ready
- ► The IG isn't done! They will continue to scrutinize our work because BIL included funding for the IG

#### Technical Assistance Grants Update

- ► Technical Assistance to Brownfields (TAB) Provider
  - ► ICMA is our current TAB provider
  - ▶ \$5 million over a 5-year period
  - ▶ Region 4 received and reviewed 3 TAB provider proposals
- Brownfields Training, Research, and Technical Assistance Grants
  - ▶ 5 new nationwide technical assistance grants focusing on 5 different focus areas: RLFs, Nonprofits, Local Government Leaders; Minimizing Displacement Research, and Land Bank Research
- Applications were due in February; expect an announcement in May or June

#### New Grantee Meetings

- Once we have the MARC award list, we'll start working on locations for the new grantee meetings and grant writing workshops
- ► The Alabama Brownfield Association has offered to host one
- We'll run options by the states before finalizing
